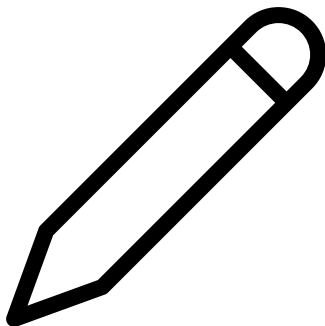

Our future generations will thank us if we act now.

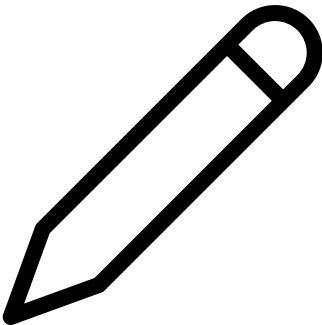
