Thanks for the opportunity to make a submission relating to the Draft Hunter Regional Plan.

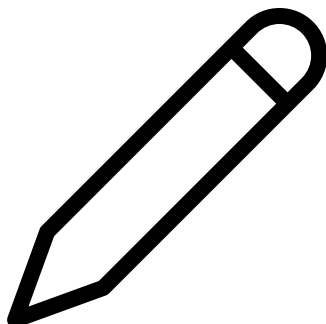

The Valley needs permanent and absolute protection for the wine industry, water resources, good farmland and villages from coal mines.

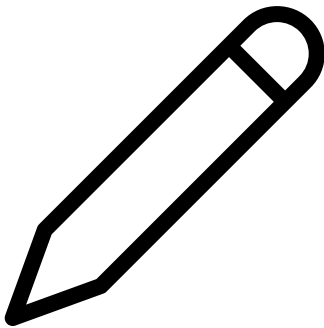
