



I am concerned that places that are currently zoned 'Hinterland' on your maps - such as Buchanan, are not currently recognised as having productive rural industries present there. While the Hunter Valley more generally is spoken of, there is small-scale production of beef cattle, poultry, horse breeding, olive groves and honey production taking place there. One property in Buchanan for example has 600 olive trees & 40 bee hives and sells its produce to stores in Newcastle and Sydney. Other producers also on-sell their produce. The plan therefore needs to ensure that these smaller hamlets are accounted for and protected especially in terms of long-term food security for the region.
