CBC Submission to the NSW Government's Draft South East and Tablelands Regional Plan

Canberra Business Chamber (CBC) supports the vision and goals articulated in the regional plan and congratulate the NSW Government on the vision it has created for the region. Tourism

CBC notes the importance of tourism for Canberra and the South East and Tablelands Region and supports strategic direction 3.1 Support and promote the growth of the tourism industry.
