## Ivanhoe Estate

Frequently Asked Questions

### Where is the Ivanhoe Estate?

The Ivanhoe Estate is a social housing estate in Macquarie Park containing 259 dwellings. The Estate is bounded by Herring Road, Epping Road and Shrimptons Creek, and is around 500 metres from Macquarie University Station.

#### Who owns the Ivanhoe Estate?

The NSW Land and Housing Corporation, part of the NSW Government, owns the Ivanhoe Estate and is planning to redevelop it into a new neighbourhood. The new neighbourhood will provide:

- 556 new homes for people who need access to social housing;
- at least 128 new homes for people who need access to affordable housing, and
- 1900 private dwellings.

# What is being changed in the *State Environmental Planning Policy* (*State and Regional Development*) 2011 (the SEPP)?

The proposed changes will specify who will be responsible for determining future proposals for redevelopment on the Ivanhoe Estate.

The Minister for Planning will be responsible for determining applications lodged by (or on behalf of) NSW Land and Housing Corporation which have a value of more than \$20 million.

Smaller developments proposals on the Ivanhoe Estate will be assessed by the local council.

#### Why do these changes need to be made?

We are working with the NSW Land and Housing Corporation to help achieve the planned redevelopment of the Ivanhoe Estate.

There is a significant opportunity to create a new, modern neighbourhood providing more homes to meet demand, including more social housing and affordable housing.
