Viva Energy Australia Pty Ltd (Viva Energy) is the owner and operator of the Viva Energy Clyde Terminal in Western Sydney. Fuels including diesel, Jet A1, and gasoline are received, stored and distributed from Clyde Terminal to the NSW market including Sydney Airport, with our supply chain managing approximately 40% of the State's fuel needs.

Within the boundary of the Clyde Terminal footprint, there is an undeveloped area of land known as the Viva Energy wetland. The wetland is approximately seven hectares in size and has been owned by Viva Energy (formally Shell) since 1965.

Viva Energy notes that the draft Coastal Management State Environmental Planning Policy (SEPP) and draft maps of the coastal management areas that make up the coastal zone include some parts of the wetland within the Clyde Terminal.

The attached letter provides a more detailed description of the wetland and makes recommendations regarding the extent of the area to be identified as wetland in the finalised "Coastal Wetland" SEPP map.
