Challenge


- Foot traffic connectivity between St Leonard and Crows Nest is sub-optimal
 - Walkways are run-down and quite unsafe (Albany St/Oxley St)
 - Walkways are boring with little points of interest
 - Walkways are loud, stressful and uncomfortable (Pacific Highway)
- There is also a need for improved public infrastructure and weekend retail

- We will use this map highlight further opportunities


Connectivity improvements
