- 4) Photon NV's asset strength, whatever it is, is based in the Netherlands, and so appears to have no relevance to satisfying any financial liabilities incurred in NSW. See, *Sustainable Energy Generator Group V. Photon Energy NV & ors*- Court of Chancery of the State of Delaware 14.1 and 10.5 2014.
- 5) I believe Photon has engaged in misleading and deceptive conduct as outlined at our Information Night, held on 27 Nov 2017, and more, that conduct has, I believe, been to our detriment.
- 6) I am aware of the commencement of the 'address our concerns' meetings with Photon. I am aware of the preliminary concerns we raised, and Photon's agreement to answer the same.
- 7) I am aware of Photon's response, and say the response is inconsistent with Photon's agreement, and does not address our concerns.
- 8) I am aware of the contents of Peta O'Hara's email to the Department, dated 29 Nov 2017, and agree with its contents.
- 9) I lack faith in Photon's integrity, and I do not want to deal with it.
- 10) I support the proposals outlined in Peta O'Hara's email dated 29 Nov 2017.
- 11) I am aware that Peta's email is consistent with the resolve on our Information Night, and am aware of her intention to forward to you the relevant parts thereof.
