## Submission in relation to the draft Hunter Region Special Infrastructure Contribution

We wish to make a submission to the draft Hunter Region Special Infrastructure Contribution (draft Hunter SIC) currently on public exhibition, with a specific focus on the equitable application of infrastructure charges to all new development.

The draft approach proposes a Lower Hunter contribution rate of \$10,664 per lot or dwelling. As the owners of land identified for future urban purposes within the Karuah Growth Strategy and additional adjacent, relatively unconstrained land holdings (area shaded blue in Figure 2), we raise concerns that the proposed contribution rate is too high and will jeopardise development feasibility for new land release developments.
