Re: Canterbury and Belmore Town Centre Alliances and support for the Sydenham to Bankstown Urban Renewal Corridor

On 28 November 2017, the Canterbury Bankstown City Council (Council) at their ordinary Council meeting debated the Sydney Metro (South-West), the Sydenham to Bankstown Urban Renewal Corridor (renewal corridor) and the NSW Department of Planning and Environment's (DP&E) '*Sydenham to Bankstown Corridor Strategy*'. The debate by Council and submissions made by the community with respect to the renewal corridor focused on the future of the corridor, potential environmental impacts, potential social impacts, delivery process and the role of Council. It was evident that the very few community attendees painted a negative image of the renewal corridor, objecting to the proposed scale of buildings, proposed residential densities and the overall political process. However, this was not reflective of wider community sentiment and given what was witnessed at these Council meetings, it was abundantly clear that Council might not be receiving the full picture in relation to the views of the entire community. Therefore, this letter aims to demonstrate that from our perspective there is an overwhelming acceptance and support for the renewal corridor, particularly in relation to the DP&E identified Priority Precincts of the Belmore and Canterbury Town Centres.

Following the initial announcement of the Sydney Metro (South-West) project and the Sydenham to Bankstown Urban Renewal Corridor, discussions commenced with key landowners within the Belmore and Canterbury Town Centres to garner the initial views of the community. Myself being a once long-time resident of Canterbury, having grown up in the town centre and still having parents that live in the town centre, it was important to understand the local sentiment towards the renewal corridor. It was obvious that many of the community responded positively to the renewal corridor. On this basis, the Canterbury and Belmore Town Centre Alliances (TCAs) were formed. I am the community representative for the Canterbury TCA, and local Belmore resident and business owner Mark Rahme is the community representative of the Belmore TCA. Within the TCAs currently there are key areas identified for future high density land uses, which a bulk of the signatories supporting this letter are found within. The specific high density areas and total number of signatories are as follows:

Canterbury TCA

- Area bounded by Broughton Street, John Street, Unwin Street, Minter Street and Canterbury Road there are 58 landowners out of 115 properties are signatories to this letter, which equates to 50% of the total number of residences;

Belmore TCA

- Area bounded by Oxford Street, Station Street, Burwood Road, Wortley Avenue and Railway Parade there are 39 landowners out of 102 properties are signatories to this letter, which equates to 38% of the total number of residences; and
- Area bounded by Acacia Lane, Leylands Parade and Acacia Street there are 31 landowners out of 39 properties are signatories to this letter, which equates to 80% of the total number of residences.

Therefore, 50% of the total number of landowners within the identified high density areas in the TCAs that were available to make representation agreed to be a signatory to this letter. Hence, these landowners have signed on in support of the urban renewal generally as proposed in the '*Sydenham to Bankstown Corridor Strategy*' (Strategy). However, we aware that there are many more landowners in the town centres that have expressed their support as well.

The strength of the TCAs is demonstrated by the number of signatories and landowners within the town centres that are willing to work in a collaborative and cooperative manner with Council, DP&E and importantly with each other in order to achieve a tremendous outcome for these centres, and in line with the stated objectives of the corridor strategy. The great benefit of these TCAs is that it allows DP&E to meet its strategic urban planning objectives for the Priority Precincts, while also providing Council an opportunity to work with landowners and DP&E towards achieving high quality design outcomes, appropriate development controls, potential to deliver great streets and a great new city. Moreover, the TCAs fully support the underlying principles of the Sydney Metro (South-West) project and the renewal corridor.

Please find attached a letter of support signed by residents and landowners in the Belmore and Canterbury Town Centres, who have come together to form TCAs.

The Belmore and Canterbury TCAs were formed to ensure that the strong support for the renewal corridor in these precincts is conveyed and heard by the relevant Government Authorities and other key stakeholders. Further, we are firmly of the view that the recent submission by Council to DP&E on the Sydney Metro (South-West), which voted to withhold support for the project and also did not endorse the proposed building heights in the '*Sydenham to Bankstown Corridor Strategy*', is in no way reflective of the true sentiment of constituents, landowners and residents of the Belmore and Canterbury Town Centre precincts.

This support is further demonstrated in the public submissions to the DP&E, with our analysis highlighting the following:

- Submissions relating to Canterbury: 64% support, 21% against, 15% issues focused - rather than for or against;
- Submissions relating to Belmore: 77% support, 16% against, 7% issues focused - rather than for or against; and
- We contend that many of the issues and objections that were raised will be dealt with in stages 2-4 of the DP&E's published rezoning process, following the '*Sydenham to Bankstown Corridor Strategy*' being adopted.

The TCAs, which represent hundreds of local residents and landowners, request that:

- Council do not ignore the TCA's support for the renewal corridor and Priority Precincts;
- DP&E progress finalising the Strategy without further delay; and
- DP&E progress the precinct planning process to address the implementation issues to begin thereafter.

This will allow our communities to fulfil their role in the growth of the city through vibrant town centres based on place-making and with clear strategic vision, and not be left behind with out of date infrastructure and lack of housing supply.

The TCAs stand ready to work with Council and DP&E to achieve an optimal outcome throughout the precinct planning process, following the '*Sydenham to Bankstown Corridor Strategy*' being adopted.
