The Department of Planning and Environment has released an interim plan for the proposed Greater Macarthur Growth Area, *Greater Macarthur 2040: An interim plan for the Greater Macarthur Growth Area*. The Growth Area extends from Glenfield to Appin. The plan is on exhibition for public comment until Friday 8 February 2019.

The Department has also prepared draft Special Infrastructure Contribution schemes that assist with funding and delivery of state infrastructure including schools, regional open space and roads. The Special Infrastructure Contribution is paid by developers after land is rezoned and subject to a development application. The draft plans can be viewed on the Department's webpage and at Campbelltown and Wollondilly councils.

Key features of the draft plan include:

- a variety of housing types and local jobs throughout Greater Macarthur
- a koala corridor and research fund
- new parks, playing fields and multipurpose sports facilities
- new primary and high schools
- improved public transport
- community health facilities
- new roads
- pedestrian and cycle connections
- draft Special Infrastructure Contribution to assist with funding and delivery of state infrastructure including schools, regional open space and roads.
