
HAVE YOUR SAY ON THE NEW EMERGENCY, SURGICAL AND CRITICAL HEALTHCARE BUILDING




DESIGN STATEMENT







PROJECT TIMELINE



TRAFFIC

There will be modifications to traffic conditions on Palmer Street and Gilmore Crescent to provide emergency services access to the facility while delivering safe traffic conditions for local users. Initial modelling suggests an overall reduction of traffic volumes on these streets.

HELIPAD

The hospital's helipad will be relocated to the northern end of the new emergency, surgical and critical healthcare building's rooftop. This location has been selected as it provides the essential clinical connection with the new building, improves helicopter operations and reduces overall noise from helicopters for the Garran community.

CONSULTATION AND ENGAGEMENT

The ACT Government has been engaging with the local community and other stakeholders for nearly a year as early plans for the Canberra Hospital Expansion have developed. This has included monthly meetings with the Local Community Reference Group and Consumer Reference Group.
