



Phase 1 consultation

Transport Canberra Rapid Bus Network What you told us.

The ACT Government undertook consultation in late 2017 to find out what people think of the public transport network. Canberrans told us they want public transport to be quicker and more frequent. People said they want more services at all times of the day and week.

Phase 1 Consultation key findings include:



Strong community support: 678 people responded to the survey. **82% use public transport.**



Almost 80% of survey respondents indicated they would be **prepared to walk further to a bus stop** if services were more frequent and journeys faster.



Amenities at interchanges are important to commuters, **including lighting, shelter and seating.**



Attractive features of the **Rapid Network** include frequent services, faster journeys and **access to a broad range of town centres.**



60% said they were keen to see more flexible bus services for **residents with limited mobility** and demand responsive services for residents who cannot access regular bus services.



Survey responses demonstrate a preference for increased availability of **mobile apps and online resources to aid journey planning** and receive updates regarding timetabling and route changes.

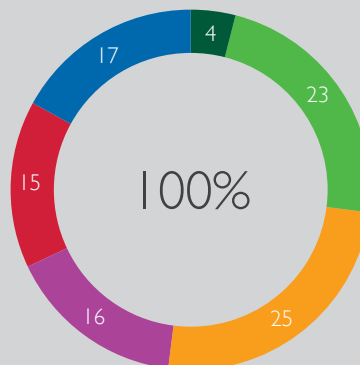
