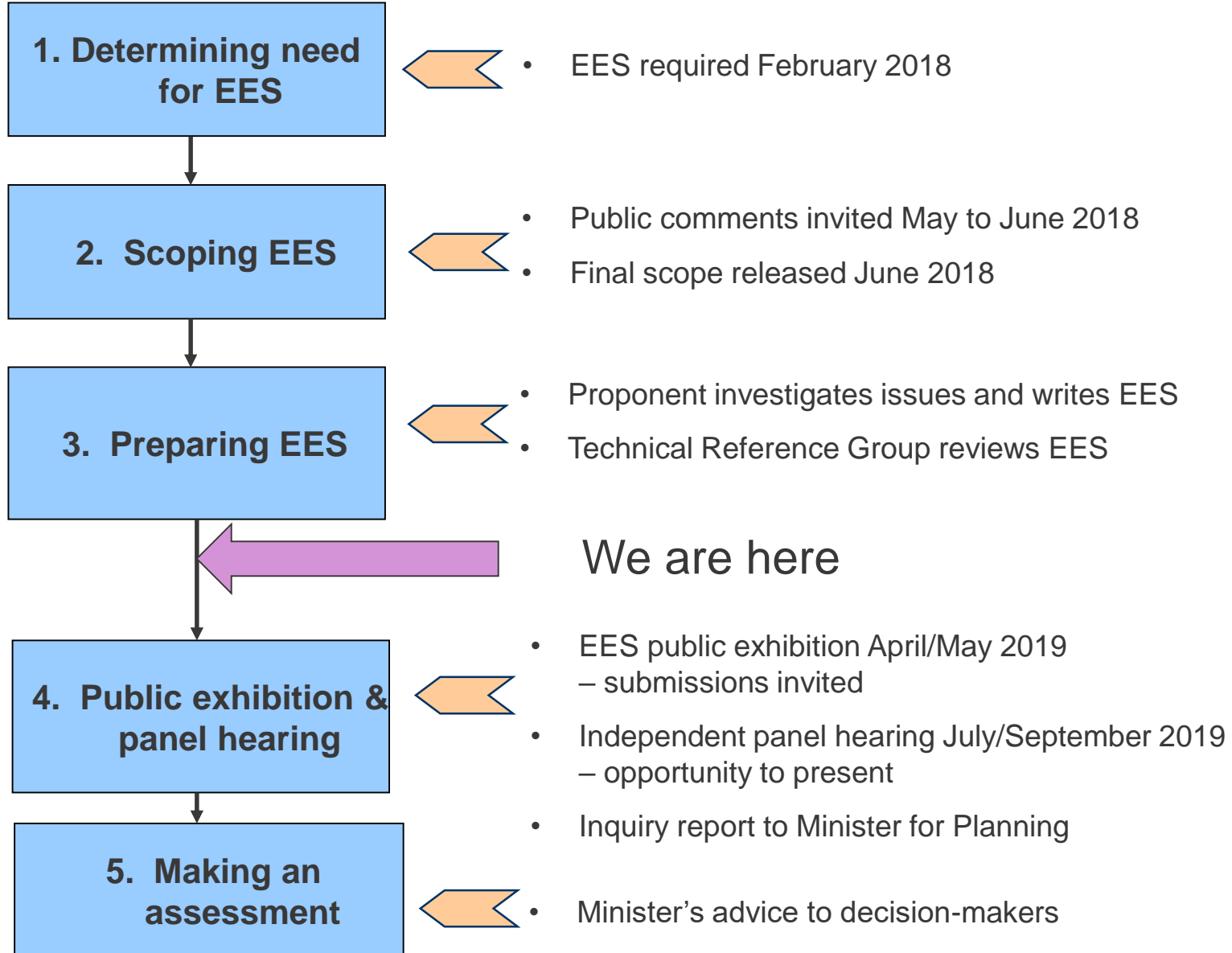

We are here

- How will I know the EES is available?
 - An advertisement in the Age will invite public submissions and North East Link proponent will advise via email/social media
- How long will I have to review the EES?
 - EES normally exhibited for six weeks
- How can I access the EES?
 - You can view EES hard copies at council offices and other locations to be advised
 - You can download EES digital files from North East Link's web site or from a USB (distribution locations to be advised)
- How can I make a submission?
 - You can fill in an on-line form at the Engage Victoria web site (to be advised) and attach your submission
 - Requests to be heard at the public hearing are via the on-line form
 - Submissions will be due by 5pm on last day of public exhibition
