New play equipment

- Swing set with an inclusive basket swing, regular swing and all-ability harness
- Shelter/cubby with climbing activities and slide
- Interactive play walls
- Softfall playground surfaces.

Landscaping improvements

- Picnic shelter with drinking fountain
- A sealed path from the gate to improve access
- Tree planting and landscaping.

The existing bench seating and picnic tables will be retained.
