Try these simple steps

1

Recycle Right

- Make sure you know what you can and can't recycle
- Stick the magnet below on your fridge to remind you

2

Sort and separate

- Always separate your garbage from your recycling
- Store your recyclables in a box or container until you're ready to visit the recycling bin
- Never put recyclable items in the garbage chute or bin

3

Cut Contamination

- If you put the wrong things in the recycling bin, it makes it harder to get the recyclables out.
- Never put plastic bags in the recycling bin: Empty your recyclables into the bin and throw the plastic bag in the garbage bin
