**COLLINS STREET, BETWEEN SPENCER AND KING STREETS, MELBOURNE
Streetscape improvement works**

The City of Melbourne is proposing works to improve the environment in the above section of Collins Street. We welcome your feedback on the enclosed concept plan.

The City of Melbourne is upgrading many of its streets as part of the Streetscape Improvement Program, which aims to enhance our streets and laneways through road and footpath works, landscaping and other improvements.

The proposal

The proposed streetscaping will improve this section of Collins Street for residents, businesses and visitors by:

- Upgrading asphalt footpaths to sawn bluestone paving. (Please note: the footpath in front of 600 Collins Street will not be upgraded to bluestone as part of these works as this property will soon be developed. We anticipate that the footpath would be upgraded as the final part of these future development works.)
- Upgrading existing street furniture and installing new stainless steel seating and rubbish and recycling bins
- Renewing the bluestone kerb and channel
- Upgrading existing tree plots with bluestone edging and porous pavement and
- Resurfacing the roadway.

The cost and timing


The \$1.1million project is planned to commence in late March 2016 and will take approximately eight weeks to complete.

Closer to the start of construction, properties along this section of Collins Street will receive information confirming the start date and timing of the works from our contractor Citywide.
