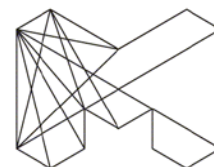

CONSTRUCTION OF STREETSCAPE IMPROVEMENT WORKS AND TEMPORARY PARKING CHANGES

Bromby Street, South Yarra

Introduction

City of Melbourne's contractor Citywide will be commencing streetscape improvement works in your area shortly.

Where will the streetscape improvement works occur?

The works will occur on both sides of the street between St Kilda Road and Domain Street.

When will construction start? How long will it take?

The works are expected to take about 15 weeks to complete.

Anticipated start date: Monday 7 April 2014

Anticipated completion date: end June 2014

What time of day will the works happen?

Works will happen mainly between 7am and 4pm Monday to Friday during the construction period above. Some weekend works may be required.

How will construction impact on the surrounding area?

Minor disruptions to property access, parking and pedestrian traffic are expected during the works.

There will also be temporary changes to on street parking arrangements.

Pedestrians will be able to use the street at all times and pedestrian access to properties will be maintained wherever possible.

All efforts will be made to keep any inconvenience to a minimum. We appreciate your patience.

How will the construction works affect parking?

To facilitate the works, we will need to make some temporary changes to parking arrangements in the area.

Parking signs will be changed to reflect the temporary restrictions which will operate for the duration of the works.

What can I do to avoid parking problems?

We urge you to check the signs before you park to ensure you are parking legally.

We thank you for your cooperation.

How long will the temporary parking changes last?

Once the works are complete, parking arrangements will return to normal – i.e. the same number of parking spaces and the same time limits.

What about my garbage collection?

Please work with our contractor on site and your neighbours to work out where to place your bins for pick-up during the works. Your collection day will not change.

Who will be doing the works?

Citywide will be carrying out the construction works on behalf of the City of Melbourne.
