

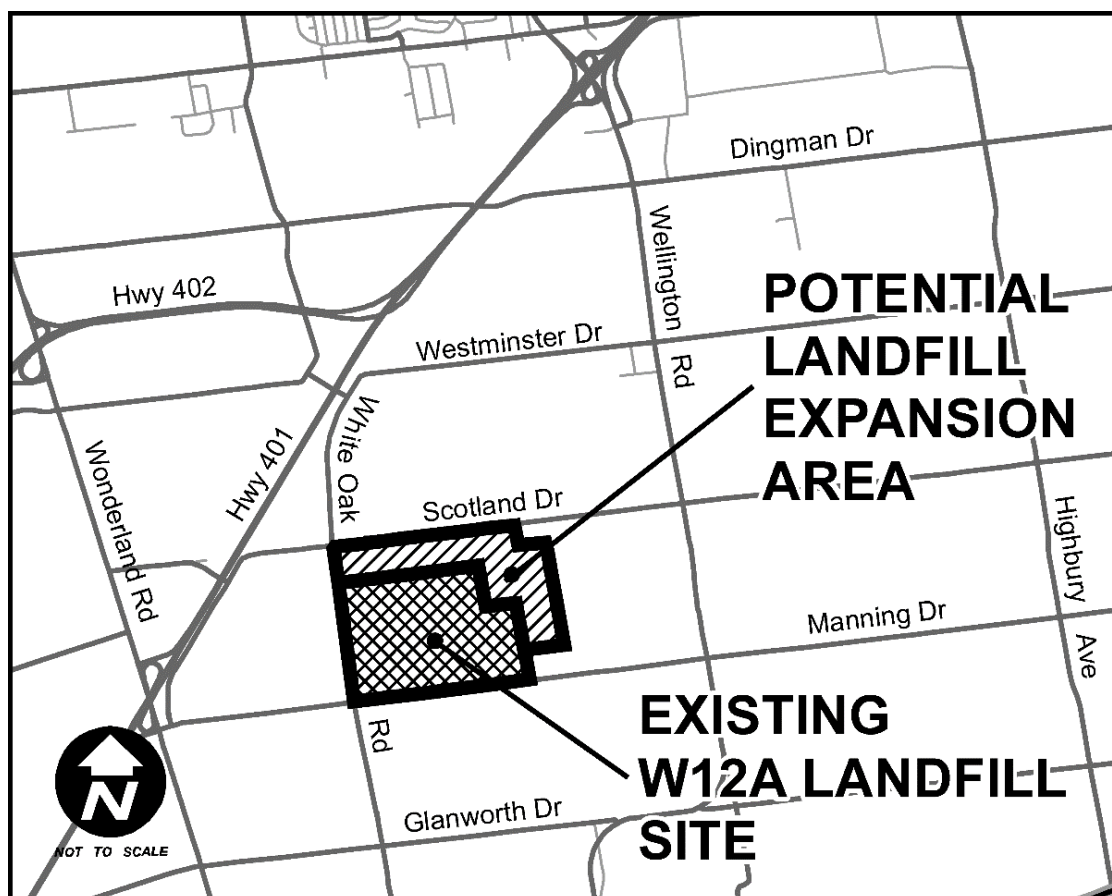


**Notice of Submission of Terms of Reference  
The Proposed W12A Landfill Expansion Environmental Assessment  
City of London**

As part of the planning process for the proposed W12A Landfill Expansion Environmental Assessment, a Terms of Reference was submitted to the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks for review as required under the Environmental Assessment Act. If approved, the Terms of Reference will serve as a framework for the preparation of the Environmental Assessment for the proposed undertaking.

**What is Being Proposed?**

The W12A Landfill is expected to reach approved capacity in 2025. It is proposed to expand the W12A Landfill by approximately 13.6 million cubic metres to extend its life to 2050 and increase the service area to a regional area, which includes: City of London, County of Huron, County of Perth, County of Elgin, County of Lambton, and County of Middlesex. The landfill expansion will occur within the area on and adjacent to the existing landfill property as shown on the map below.



## **Review of the Terms of Reference**

Members of the public, government agencies, Indigenous communities and other interested persons may inspect the Terms of Reference and provide comments from October 12, 2018 to November 12, 2018.
