Notice of Public Participation Meeting: One River Master Plan Environmental Assessment, Phase 2 Stage 1: Recommended Option for Springbank Dam. Civic Works Committee, Tuesday, January 9, 2018, not to be heard before 5:45 PM.

The City of London has retained CH2M to undertake a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for the One River Master Plan. The Stage 1 Environmental Assessment Report will be available to the public on getinvolved.london.ca/OneRiver by December 15, 2017. The report provides a recommended option for Springbank Dam, which will be presented for public comment.
