

## Environmental Assessment Process Steps

## Phase 1 – Terms of Reference

Who completes	Step	Key features/ explanation of actions
City of London	Develop	<ul> <li>Notice to interested persons and groups of the start of the ToR process.</li> <li>Community engagement with the public, Indigenous communities and government agencies.</li> <li>Completion of a ToR document that includes: <ul> <li>the purpose of the study</li> <li>a description of the study and the alternatives being considered</li> <li>an outline of the plan for evaluating the alternatives and completing the environmental assessment</li> <li>a description of the existing environment and potential effects of the alternatives</li> <li>a description of the community engagement process and how input was considered</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
City of London	Submit Report	<ul> <li>When submitting the ToR to the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change (MOECC), the City must send a notice to interested persons and groups.</li> </ul>
Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change (MOECC)	Government Review	<ul> <li>The MOECC will consult with the public, Indigenous communities and Government agencies about the ToR and make a recommendation to the Minister who decides whether or not to approve the ToR.</li> </ul>
MOECC	Minister Decision	<ul> <li>The Minister can refer a matter to mediation before making a decision or the proponent (City) can begin the mediation process. The Minister can approve or reject a ToR.</li> </ul>
