2. The author or creator must live, work or study in the City of Melton.
3. Employees and family members of Melton City Council cannot submit story entries.
4. Submissions must be original stories by the author and creator.
5. Stories must respond to the themes of social connections in Melton and or celebrating racial diversity.
6. All content and themes must be child friendly and suitable for the wider community.
- 5 The organisers reserve the right to remove an unsuitable submissions.
6. Submitted stories are not to share personal information, addresses or business brands.
7. Submissions will be selected for publishing by a panel within the City of Melton.
8. Selected submissions will be notified of vouchers before publishing.
9. The first ten submissions will be notified of their voucher within a week of submission.
10. Selected stories and full name will be published online by Melton City Council, by entering, you agree to have your work published. Please notify us upon submission if you do not want your full name published (first name only).
11. By submitting your stories, you are consenting to publishing your stories and full name online. Please tell us if you do not want your full name published.
12. You may also be contacted by the mural artists for further consultation as part of the creative research process. Please tell us if you do not want to be contacted by the artist.
