



## M41 Merri Creek to MCG Water Main Renewal Project September 2018

### Upcoming construction works on Victoria Parade

The M41 water main supplies drinking water to over 350,000 residents and businesses in Melbourne's inner suburbs. It runs from Merri Creek, Northcote to Wellington Parade, East Melbourne. The existing water main is almost 100 years old and deteriorating and needs to be replaced to prevent leaks which have created significant community disturbance during emergency repair works.

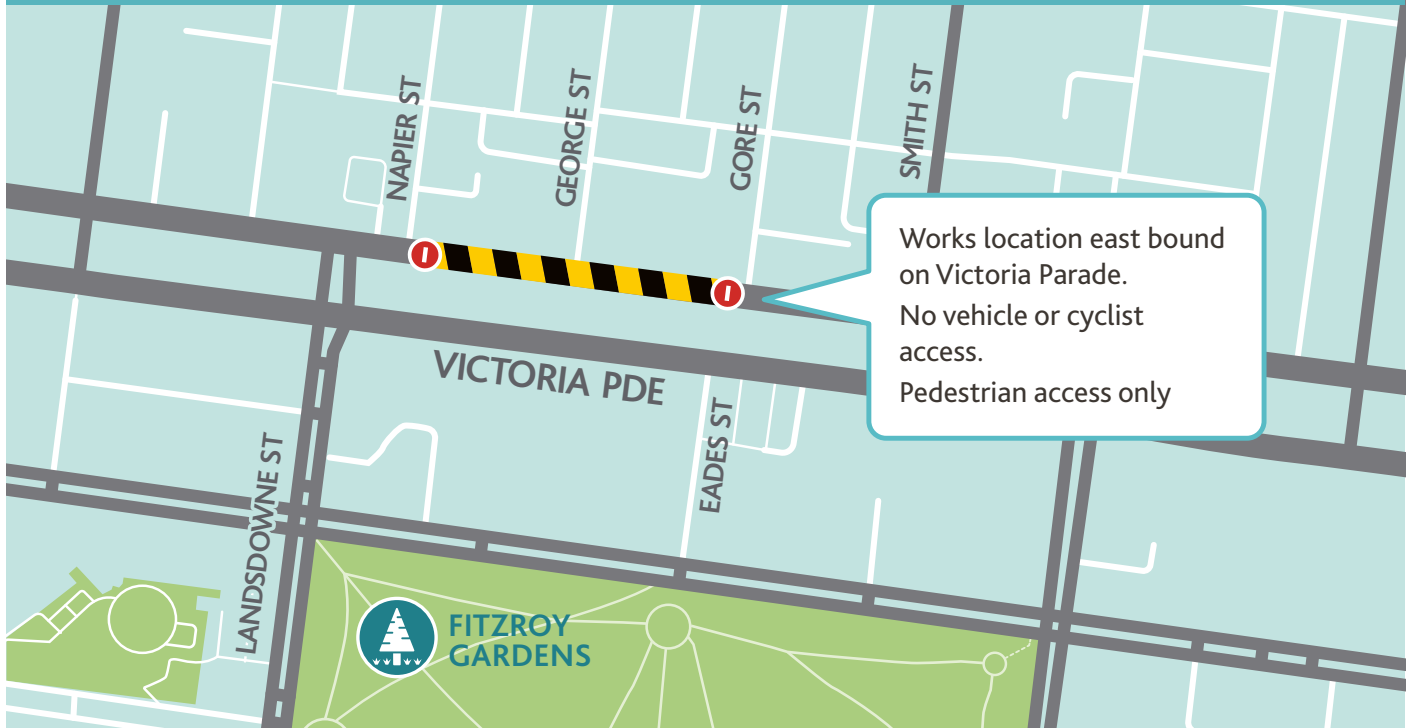
Construction of the M41 Merri Creek to MCG Water Main Renewal Project will commence on Victoria Parade, Fitzroy from 11pm Friday 21 September.

Work crews will work day and night, 24 hours per day, through this period to complete the water main renewal works. Temporary full road closures and reduced lanes will apply at times during this period.



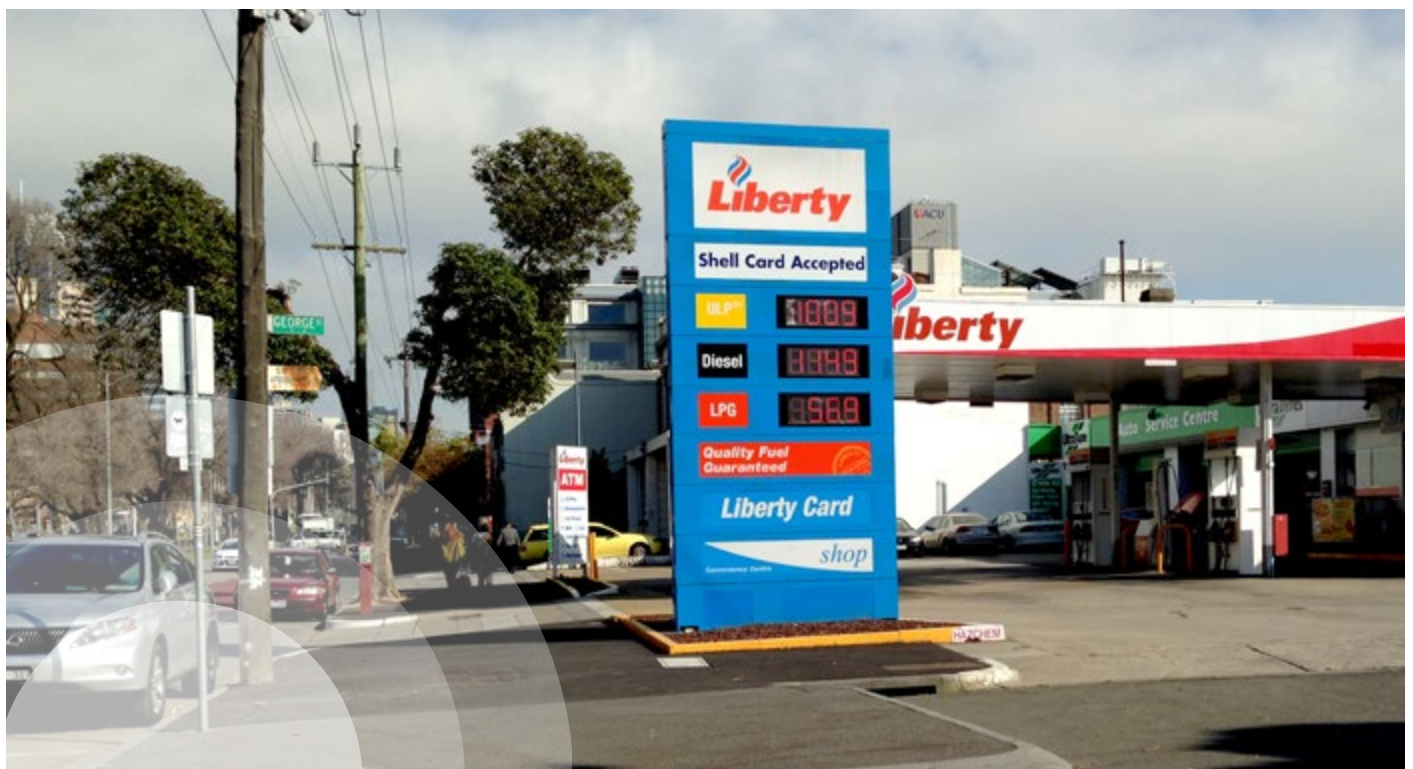
## Victoria Parade – east bound full closure day and night works

11pm Friday 21 September to 9am Monday 24 September 2018



Victoria Parade will be closed to all vehicles, including buses, in the construction corridor detailed above.

The full road closure of the east bound carriageway will commence from **11pm on Friday 21 September through until 9am Monday 24 September**.

## Installation of the new water main Construction hours

The project will be excavating the road surface to lay the new pipe. This is done through the use of a large excavator. The trench is approximately 3m deep and 20m long to install the new 1.2m diameter steel pipe. These pipes range in lengths from 6.5m to 13.5m.

You will notice a large work crew, excavators, compaction rollers and construction vehicles within the work zone.

### Temporary changes to on-street parking, off-street parking and vehicle access to driveways

There will be no on-street parking and no vehicle access available within the work zone while the works are undertaken. This includes temporary loss of some parking bays on Victoria Parade.

### Traffic detours

Motorists and pedestrians are asked to observe all traffic management, signage and temporary speed reductions in the area. Please allow extra travel time.

### What can you expect

- Day and night works
- Site establishment with temporary fencing erected to delineate the work zone
- Temporary loss of vehicle access to driveways and off-street car parking on Victoria Parade
- Temporary changes to on-street parking and traffic conditions
- Temporary lane and road closures and changes to the speed limits near work areas
- Noise from various construction plant, vehicle and activities such as rock breaking
- Dust and vibration
- Light towers at night. The project will direct lighting away from residential properties where possible.
- Increased construction vehicle movement in local area

- The east bound carriageway road closure works on Victoria Parade will be performed 24hrs per day from 11pm Friday 21 September to 9am Monday 24 September 2018
- The reduced lane east bound and west bound works on Victoria Parade will be performed 24hrs per day from 5am Monday 24 September to Monday 8 October 2018 and additionally Sunday 30 September to Monday 8 October 2018 for east bound.
- No works will be undertaken during the AFL Grand Final period, from the morning of Friday 28 September to the morning Sunday 30 September 2018. Traffic detours will remain in place.
