



Stony Creek Rehabilitation

Workshop information sheet

Over the coming months, Melbourne Water will work in close partnership with Maribyrnong City Council, Environment Protection Authority (EPA), other relevant agencies and the local community to develop a plan to support the long-term rehabilitation of Stony Creek and its surrounding environment. This planning will occur as we continue the recovery works that have been ongoing since the warehouse fire in West Footscray last year.

To ensure that the Stony Creek Rehabilitation Plan is developed in collaboration with the local community, we're looking for interested people to join a two-day community workshop.

Purpose of the community workshop

The intent of the workshop is to:

- Further understand what the local community values about Stony Creek and their ideas and aspirations for rehabilitation
- Gain an in-depth understanding of challenges and opportunities for rehabilitating the creek
- Outline objectives and desired outcomes for the plan
- Identify key priorities, actions and projects to incorporate into the plan.

What's involved?

Joining Melbourne Water at the workshop will be representatives from Maribyrnong City Council, the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) and other relevant government agencies.

Workshop participants will be expected to:

- Contribute local knowledge on Stony Creek and community values
- Contribute local knowledge on potential challenges and opportunities for rehabilitating the creek
- Provide ideas for actions and projects
- Work as part of a group to outline objectives and desired outcomes for the plan, and identify overarching priorities that represent all community interests.

Workshop details

The workshop will be held over two days at a location in Footscray:

Day 1: Sunday 17 March, 9.30am – 4pm

Day 2: Sunday 24 March, 9.30am – 4pm

To participate, **you must be available to attend both sessions**. As a thank you for participating in the two-day workshop, all members will receive a \$100 gift card.

There are up to 30 positions available at the workshop for local community members.

Participants will be selected through an independently-managed recruitment process to ensure that there is an appropriate demographic representation of the local community.
