Dear resident,

Murrumbeena to Malvern Flood Mitigation Project – Night works Glen Waverley rail corridor, Malvern East.

We wish to advise you of upcoming night works to locate underground services as part of the Murrumbeena to Malvern Flood Mitigation Project.

These works will not impact your property or water or sewerage services.

Timing

Our works will occur:

- **9 pm to 4 am** Sunday 26 February 2017
- **9 pm to 4 am** Monday 27 February 2017
- **9 pm to 4 am** Tuesday 28 February 2017
- **9 pm to 4 am** Wednesday 29 February 2017.

Location of works

We will be working in the rail corridor of the Glen Waverley line as shown in red on the map below.



What we are doing

- Using ground-penetrating radar to locate underground services.
- Exposing these underground services using a non-destructive digging truck (NDD truck), recording the location.
- Reinstating our work areas.

What you may experience during these works

While these works will not impact your property, you may notice:

- Noise generated from the NDD truck and site vehicles when in use.
- Traffic management including signage and personnel safely guiding pedestrians and cyclists safely around the works.
- Construction vehicles (NDD truck and light vehicles) accessing the site

About the project

Melbourne Water is planning to construct a new stormwater drain to minimise the impacts of flooding to properties in Murrumbeena and Malvern East.

The new stormwater drain will collect water from heavy rainfall that flows over the streets and paved surfaces, reducing the impact of flooding.

Melbourne Water has engaged engineering consultants GHD to undertake the functional design phase of the Murrumbeena to Malvern Flood Mitigation Project.

We are working closely with City of Stonnington and Glen Eira City Councils, locally affected residents and other agencies to minimise any inconvenience to residents throughout the project.

This work may be rescheduled in the event of unsuitable weather or other unavoidable circumstances. We apologise for any inconvenience and appreciate your understanding.
