

M41 Merri Creek to MCG Water Main Renewal Project

Construction update June 2019

The M41 water main runs from Merri Creek, Northcote to Wellington Parade, East Melbourne and supplies drinking water to over 350,000 residents and businesses. After almost 100 years, the existing water main is deteriorating and needs to be replaced to prevent leaks which have created significant community disturbance during emergency repair works.

Reinstatement of Kerr Street and Napier Street, Fitzroy

This update is to provide further information on the asphaltting of **Kerr Street** and **Napier Street**. The project will permanently reinstate the road, from kerb to kerb, from **Monday 1 July 2019**, at the following locations;

- Reinstatement of the bluestone kerbing in the **George Street** and **Kerr Street intersection** will commence on **Wednesday 26 June 2019**. The intersection will remain open to traffic.
- **Kerr Street**, from **George Street** to **Napier Street**, commencing **Monday 1 July 2019**, reopening by **6pm** on **Friday 5 July 2019**.
- **Napier Street**, from **Kerr Street** to **Rose Street**, commencing **Monday 1 July 2019**, reopening by **6pm** on **Friday 5 July 2019**.
- **Napier Street**, from **Rose Street** to **Cecil Street**, commencing **Wednesday 3 July 2019**, reopening by **6pm** on **Tuesday 9 July 2019**.

Temporary changes to on-street parking, off-street parking and vehicle access to driveways

There will be no on-street parking and no vehicle access available within the work zone while the works are undertaken. This includes temporary loss of vehicle access to driveways and off-street car parks.

Please keep in mind that as a result of these temporary road closures, there will be limited on-street parking available in neighbouring streets for both local residents and businesses.

The project will reopen the road as soon as it is safe to do so, weather permitting.

Traffic detours

There will be local traffic management and detours in place during working hours. Our traffic controllers will be on duty at each work location to ensure traffic and pedestrians can navigate around our worksite safely during working hours. Please follow the signage and direction of our traffic controllers and allow extra travel time.



What can you expect

- Site establishment with temporary barriers delineating the work zone
- Temporary changes to on-street parking and traffic conditions
- Temporary lane and road closures and changes to the speed limits near work areas
- Noise from various construction plant, vehicle and construction activities
- Dust and vibration
- Increased construction vehicle movement in local area

Construction hours

These works will be performed during the day between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **Saturday between 9am to 3pm**.
