

# Murrumbeena to Malvern Flood Mitigation Project

## Stage 1 is nearly complete

Melbourne Water is pleased to advise that Stage 1 of the Murrumbeena to Malvern Flood Mitigation Project is almost complete with remaining works due to finish by the end of May 2018, weather permitting.

Stage 1 of the Murrumbeena to Malvern Flood Mitigation Project involved installing approximately 100m of new stormwater pipes under the Glen Waverley Railway line and through O.T. Flight Reserve in Malvern East.

### What we have completed:

- Open-cut trenching across the Glen Waverley railway line and through O.T. Flight Reserve
- Relocation of underground services
- Construction of two new drainage pits.

The project is designed to reduce flooding in an area which is heavily affected during high rainfall events. This was evident in 2006 and again in 2011, when flooding caused damage to properties in Bute Street, Murrumbeena and The Rialto, Malvern East.

The new stormwater drain will collect water from heavy rainfall that flows over the streets and paved surfaces, reducing the impact of flooding to properties in the area.

### What is left to do?

- Reinststate the noise walls adjacent to the Monash Freeway
- Reinststate the shared use path and remove the temporary path
- Remove site sheds and temporary fencing
- Reinststate O.T. Flight Reserve and grass seed the work area
