



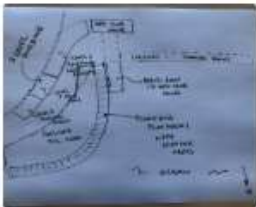

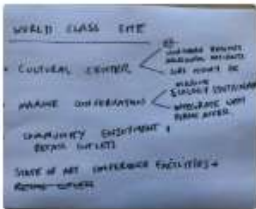


Sketch idea for site

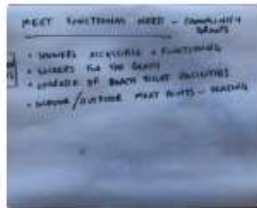
