Triangle Park Naming Competition

Naming Competition Process

1. Purpose is to rename the area colloquially known as Triangle Park but officially as Dee Why Town Square.
2. Process will involve 2 stages.
3. Stage 1 will call for suggestions, with entrants going in the draw to win one of three double movie passes (The Competition). Suggestions will be shortlisted by a panel comprising of a Councillor from A Ward, B Ward, The Mayor, DGM Environment and the Project Manager.
4. Stage 2 will ask the community to vote on the above shortlist.
5. A Council report will be prepared seeking Council endorsement for the name change.
6. Following Council adoption, an application will be made to the Geographical Names Board.

Competition Terms and Conditions

1. The Promoter is Warringah Council of 725 Pittwater Road, DEE WHY, NSW, 2099.
2. Competition commences 12 February 2016.
3. Entries close 5pm, Sunday 13 March 2016.
4. The competition is open to anyone who submitted a name suggestion for Triangle Park in accordance with the Terms & Conditions stipulated here.
5. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to win prizes. However they can still submit naming suggestion/s.
6. An entrant only gets 1 entry into the draw, regardless of the number of names suggested.
7. No entry is valid unless it provides the entrants full name, address, email address and phone number.
8. Naming suggestions may be submitted:
 - 8.1. Via completion of an entry form submitted at the community information day held in Triangle Park 20 February 2016.

9. Related prizes are 3 x Double Movie Tickets valued at \$50 each.
10. The winner will be selected at random, regardless of whether their suggested name is nominated for a popular vote.
11. Prize winners will be notified via email or contacted by phone. The prize draw will be made within one week of closing date. If the winners

are unable to be contacted or have failed to reply after seven days from the date of the draw, another winner will be drawn in accordance with the above conditions.

12. Prizes will be issued upon verification of a contestant's eligibility which will be determined by the Council Officers conducting the prize draw.
13. The prize vouchers will be sent by mail to the winners.
14. Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
15. Any name suggestions will only be used by the Promoter to shortlist a number of suggestions. The most voted for option will be chosen by a popular vote.
16. Prize is not redeemable for cash. Prize is non-transferable.
