



# Resident Parking Permits

We're making changes to parking permit pricing to encourage understanding of the true value of parking permits and to further manage increasing demand across the City.

## WHAT WE ASKED\*

Should the first Resident Parking Permit be cheaper, and the cost increase cost for extra permits per household?

## WHAT YOU TOLD US\*

**61%**  
of residents

agreed that the first Resident Parking Permit should be cheaper.

## WHAT IS HAPPENING

Introduce tiered pricing for Resident Parking Permits (\$83 each per annum in 2020), based on the number of permits per household:

- 1 \$60 first permit
- 2 \$120 second permit
- 3 \$120 third permit (only available for existing permit holders; available until 30 June 2025.)

Concession card holders are entitled to receive their first annual Resident Parking Permit free of charge, with subsequent permits charged at half.

## EXPECTED OUTCOMES

- 1 Manage and respond to supply and demand in residential areas.
- 2 Promote use of existing parking resources to reduce pressure on local parking availability.
- 3 Encourage reduced car ownership and car dependence and greater use of alternative, sustainable modes of transport.

## TIMELINE

Effective 1 July 2021
