I can only describe my experiences and treatment from the agency over the last nine months to be only short of physical violence in terms of the assault against my person. The effect on my health has not been positive and in other places and circumstances should result in criminal charges against the offenders. I read nothing in the Act or proposed changes that will prevent such behaviour and others such as Rachmanism from occurring in the future.

Quite simply the "us vs. them" environment fostered by Victorian law and practice yet again highlights the mockery of the Victorian Human Rights legislation which supposedly creates equality amongst all. . . How can my situation be equal to other Victorian citizens signing leases after 01.07.2020 in respect of protection from asbestos, failure to undertake essential repairs, protection from power boards & circuit breakers that have been seen to be ineffective and that I have been told verbally by an attending electrician were in need of replacement and update but I am now told certification was obtained but a requested copy is not forthcoming. How do I, who once worked for a company who had a fellow employee decapitated by airborne sheet metal cope with the gaslighting attempted by the housing clerk that new 2 metre long sheets of corrugated iron recently affixed to rotting wooden posts erected upto thirty years for 1.5 metre high fencing that are now blowing in the wind is a non urgent unessential repair?

It is in my opinion assault no different to being hit by an iron bar.

That I will not be given protection in five years time because the landlord is not required to tell me that there is asbestos insulation in the attic or that there is a gas leak under the house is obscene endangerment of life to say nothing of failing to create the citizen equality supposedly existing in Victoria.
