

Works occurring on new intersection

New Youth Justice Centre – Cherry Creek

The Victorian Government is building a new youth justice centre to the west of Werribee, in the vicinity of Cherry Creek.

Providing a new youth justice facility is an essential part of the government's commitment to improving community safety and modernising Victoria's youth justice system.

The new youth justice centre will play a key role in the rehabilitation of young people and children who are offending and improve community safety.

Upcoming works in Little River

To provide vehicles with safe and easy access to the new youth justice facility, a new intersection featuring a turning lane is being constructed on Little River Road.

The turning lane will provide motorists driving westbound along Little River Road (including traffic exiting the Princes Freeway) with a separate lane to turn right on the facility's access road.

This will ensure there is minimal impact to westbound traffic and vehicles exiting the Freeway and continuing to travel Westbound along Little River Road.

The intersection has been designed in consultation with VicRoads, Wyndham City Council and independent engineering consultants.

Works will also occur on the left turn off ramp from the Princes Freeway. The ramp will be realigned to improve the sight lines for vehicles exiting the Freeway.

When will work occur?

Works will commence on Friday 5 of July 2019 and are expected to be completed by September 2019.

Traffic changes

During the construction of the new intersection and turning lane there will be disruptions to traffic on Little River Road.

Minor delays on Little River Road

Throughout the construction of the slip lanes it is expected that there will be short delays on Little River Road.

During works a single lane will be put in place for vehicle use for a distance of about 400 meters next to the intersection.

The single lane access will commence on Friday 5 of July 2019 and is expected to return to a dual lane road by September.

Reduction in speed limit

Throughout the construction period the speed limit near the intersection will be reduced from 100 kilometres an hour to 40 kilometres an hour.

Additional vehicles

There will also be a temporary increase in truck movement, with materials being delivered to the site during working hours.
