Please ensure you have reviewed the Draft Victorian Visa Nomination Occupation List before submitting your feedback.

Discussion Questions

The following questions relate to the Draft Victorian Visa Nomination Occupation List.

For each occupation you wish to provide feedback on, please consider the below questions in your response. **Please include any relevant to evidence to support your claims.**

1. Should the occupation be added to, remain on or removed from the draft occupation list?
2. Are there any regions of Victoria that are experiencing a shortage of the occupation?
3. Should candidates hold a minimum qualification to be eligible for nomination in this occupation?
4. Should candidates hold minimum years of experience to be eligible for nomination in this occupation?
5. Are there any specialist skills in shortage in this occupation?

Tips for making a good submission

While the Department encourages you to provide a wide range of evidence to support your response, please note the below tips:

- Be concise.
- Use the ANZSCO 6-digit code when referring to an occupation.
- Where possible, support any claims with robust evidence.

We define 'robust evidence' as evidence that is:

- relevant and recent data or information
- accurate and easily interpreted
- unbiased and representative of whole of industry in Victoria and/or region
- publicly available (where possible) and the source clearly identified.
