Can you please provide more clarification. We ask because our block of land is quite large, many of our neighbouring blocks are being subdivided into much smaller blocks and we believe we should retain the right to do the same.

We think that the boundary nominated between the 2 different designated areas along our street, 'Increased Housing Diversity area' and 'Incremental change Area' is very random, and the whole street should be included in the same area. It seems more reasonable that Geelong Rd would be a more natural demarcation line.

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It is very hard, if not impossible to discover what will be the policy differences between the 2 areas and so we may be being disadvantaged without the correct information being provided.

Any subdivision would not affect any of the values that are outlined in the proposed policy
