Mordialloc Bypass Project – Environmental Effects Statement (EES) Inquiry and Advisory Committee

We refer to the submission made by Kingston City Council (**Council**) to the Inquiry and Advisory Committee (**IAC**) with respect to the Mordialloc Bypass Project (**Project**) EES.

We advise that the submission failed to mention a second opportunity to create a wetlands near the connection of the Dingley Bypass with the proposed Project alignment to clean stormwater and provide treated water for use in Council's Green Wedge Zone. We **enclose** *Investigation of Integrated Stormwater Management Opportunities* document dated December 2012 and schematic of the proposed Bypass alignment indicating the location of this second potential wetland opportunity.

Although Council failed to mention this second potential wetland project in the submission, we understand both potential wetland projects have been raised previously with representatives of the proponent, Major Road Projects Victoria (**MRPV**).

We advise that Council will be raising this second stormwater management opportunity as part of the IAC process and seeking that it be incorporated into the Project. We do not anticipate that this will affect Council's allocated time to present its submission to the IAC.

We confirm that we have provided this letter to all parties on the IAC distribution list, including MRPV.
