We are concerned that it appears that the Queenscliff Council and The Bellarine Catchment network place this area as low priority. This is disappointing especially as they promote and work actively in other areas, which are often hidden from view.

We feel that with some support we can engage and activate local residents to assist us and we are looking for guidance. Our requests to explain and show the relevant authorities and organisations to support us have been less that fruitful.
