

This Privacy Collection Statement relates to all submissions collected in relation to the Planning Scheme Amendment Melbourne C281. Planning Panels Victoria (PPV) is providing administrative services in collecting submissions.

PPV is part of the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning and submissions will be managed in accordance with the Department's Information Privacy Policy. The Department's Information Privacy Policy is online at www.delwp.vic.gov.au/privacy.

Use of your submission

Your submission has been collected on behalf of the Minister for Planning (the Planning Authority). In the first instance your submission will be forwarded to the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning for the purpose of helping to develop its advice regarding the amendment to the Minister for Planning.

Your submission will also be provided to the City of Melbourne, the proponent, Village Park Consortium and their planning consultant so that these parties can consider your submission and potentially propose changes to the amendment in order to address issues raised in submissions. In accordance with the Planning and Environment Regulations 2015 copies of all submissions will also be made publicly available by the Planning Authority until the end of two months after the amendment comes into operation or lapses (your address, but no other contact details will be included in the public version).

The contact details you have provided may be used by either the planning authority or PPV to notify you about the progress of the amendment.

Should a Panel be required, natural justice to participants and transparency are important parts of the Panel process. In meeting its legislative requirements, the Panel may do the following with your submission (your address but no other contact details will be included):

- Provide a copy of your submission to the Proponent, Local Councils, Government Agencies and other parties (submitters) to the Hearing.
- Provide a copy of your submission to the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning if needed for preparing Ministerial briefings.
- Display a copy of your submission in the Planning Panels Victoria Office.
- Display a copy of your submission at the relevant Local Council Office or Government Office as appropriate.
- If a Public Hearing is to be held, display a copy of your submission in the Hearing room.

Publication of your personal information on the Internet

In the event of a Panel, a Panel Report will be published on the internet and may include:

- The name of the submitter;

- Direct quotes from some of the submission; and
- The submitter's name and address as required.

Please note that even when we remove your personal information from the internet, it may remain on external servers indefinitely.

After the Panel has reported to the Minister for Planning, your submission will be removed from all public display.

Your original submission and any additional material provided will be held at Planning Panels Victoria for two years and then sent to the Public Records Office of Victoria. All additional copies of the submission and other material held by Planning Panels Victoria will be securely destroyed.
