Dear Greta

Please convey to the IAC, the Friends of Mordialloc Catchment support for Judith Sise online submission and presentation to the IAC on Tuesday 12 March 2019. In particular her points on:

1. Conservation of and risk to biodiversity from the construction and presence of the Mordialloc Freeway.
2. The risk to insect populations that are essential for ecosystem services, the wildlife food chain, and pollination of native and food plants, due to road kill, changed conditions or decimation from loss of habitat.
3. The risk to fungi, mosses and lichen from changed conditions or loss of habitat.
4. The risk of unidentified flora and fauna species being lost due to inadequate data and field surveys.

As far as I am aware, points 2-4 above have not been covered, but other environmental and social impacts have generally been well covered.
