# Works Notification

## Site establishment and start of works

### South Yarra Station

October 2020

We're upgrading South Yarra Station, one of Melbourne's busiest stations, as we also prepare our network for the Metro Tunnel.

The South Yarra Station Upgrade will create a safer and more accessible space, with improvements to the entrance area and amenities, a new canopy over the station entrance and an accessible tram stop on Toorak Road.

#### What we are doing

In October, works will commence at the station entrance and inside the concourse.

These works include:


- Temporarily closing one parking space and establishing a project site laydown area in the private car park on Darling Street, for the storage of construction materials
- Installing temporary fencing and hoarding around the perimeter of the work site and laydown area
- Demolishing the existing café at the station, so we can widen the station entrance
- Commencement of works to refurbish the concourse area, upgrade the booking and staff office facilities, increase the number of myki gates and improve their layout, and upgrade customer wayfinding.

#### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise and low levels of dust
- Pedestrian access to the station and shops will be maintained at all times
- Wayfinding signage and traffic management will be in place to direct passengers safely around the worksite as required
- For the safety of rail users and our workers, we need to complete some of these activities out of hours when trains are not running. See over for details of upcoming night works
- There will be no impact to train services at South Yarra Station as a result of this project.

## When

- From Thursday 1 October to March 2021
- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- Night works from 8pm to 4.30am, Monday 5 October to Tuesday 20 October (weekdays only) to complete civil and structural works. This includes demolishing the existing cafe, installation of hoarding and structural beams.

The timing of these works may change depending on weather or unavoidable circumstances.

## Health and safety

Critical infrastructure projects will continue during COVID-19 restrictions. This includes safety and maintenance works on roads and public transport, and road safety projects that maintain critical safe operations on the road network. To ensure the safety of all workers and the community, all construction and maintenance work undertaken will operate under a High Risk COVID Safe plan.
