Comments: 1. I oppose duplication of Templestowe Rd. This is unnecessary given the current level of traffic, would require destruction of significant numbers of trees and would destroy its current semi-rural character. In addition, I oppose plans to direct increased traffic flows onto this road due to the associated pollution and noise. 2. I prefer retention of the HM Clause seed farm at 165 Templestowe Rd to its conversion to "active recreation" (sports fields), with consequent increased traffic and noise. 3. The strongest possible representations should be made to the NE Link project to ensure that the current recommendation to preserve the Bridge St River Red Gum (HO24) is carried out. 4. I oppose housing development on the north (river) side of Templestowe Rd on the Sonoco site which seems inconsistent with the general environmental objectives of the plan. 5. I urge retention of the Greenery Nursery as it provides a convenient service to the area. 6. I support the proposed cycle/foot bridges over the Yarra to facilitate commuter cycle access to Heidelberg and if possible Eaglemont stations. Sufficient cycle parking should be provided at these stations. This could help relieve the tight car parking situation at these stations.
