Re: Draft Bellarine Peninsula Statement Of Planning Policy

To whom it may concern,

My husband and I don't want to see Curlewis turned into a giant housing estate. There is currently a lot of farmland around the Curlewis area which if allowed to be rezoned would encourage large scale housing developments impacting detrimentally on the environment. Zoning laws need to be strictly enforced and made so that future development in these areas is restricted and includes a large proportion of green areas (including habitat for native animals, birds, etc.). Natural reserves are needed for the wellbeing of residents. So, we would strongly urge DELWP to consider having extensive green areas throughout any housing developments that are going to occur in this area in the future. Looking at current housing development, it can be seen that in some places not enough is being done to give natural habitat for animals, birds, etc. and also green areas for public use.
