Education, good health and wellbeing transform lives

How can schools deliver all these services for our community?

This question is the focus of the Frankston North Education Plan, involving Aldercourt Primary, Mahogany Rise Primary and Monterey Secondary College.

From 9 – 29 October in 2017, the Victorian School Building Authority came to ask for your feedback. We did this with an online survey, community pop-ups at the schools and at the local community centre. We also ran engagement workshops to gather the thoughts of parents, locals, teachers and students.

All feedback is helping to inform the education plan, with recommendations due to be released in Q1, 2018.
