BARWON HEADS ROAD DUPLICATION

WALKING AND CYCLING



We're building a walking and cycling path along Barwon Heads Road to make your journey safer and improve access to the local area.

Where will the path go?

The path will run along the eastern side of Barwon Heads Road, between Settlement Road and Crows Road in Belmont, near the South Barwon Reserve. At Crows Road, the path will cross the intersection to the western side of the road, improving access to residential areas in Marshall.

The path will also extend over the bridge at the railway line at Marshall, and continue to Reserve Road in Charlemont.

What are the features and benefits of the path?

The path and the surrounding area will include:

- A safe off-road travel option, safer ways to cross major intersections and train tracks at Marshall, and a safer way to access public transport
- It will be at least three metres wide to accommodate pedestrians and cyclists

- Better path connectivity to the Waurin Ponds Trail, the South Barwon Reserve, Belmont Common and the Barwon River Precinct
- A continuous path from Belmont to Charlemont.

A 1.5m on-road bike lane will also be constructed.
