Mordialloc Bypass Project – Environmental Effects Statement (EES) Inquiry and Advisory Committee

We refer to the directions letter dated 5 February 2019 issued by the Inquiry and Advisory Committee (IAC) with respect to the Mordialloc Bypass Project EES.

Attendance at Inspection

We advise that not more than two people will attend the inspection on the provided bus on behalf of Kingston City Council. We will advise specifically who these people will be as soon as we are able.

Inspection Locations

There are viewing points highlighted in the evidence of Tim Biles, Message Consultants. We will be referring the IAC Panel to a number of specified viewing points during the IAC Hearing. The IAC Panel may wish to determine which of these viewing points warrant an accompanied inspection or whether the IAC Panel will be content to view these locations itself.

If the IAC Panel considers that an accompanied inspection as noted above is warranted, we suggest the below significant locations:

- 1 the roundabout intersection of Waterside Drive and Mitta Avenue, Waterways;
- 2 Bowen Parkway, Aspendale Gardens, at Mordialloc Creek Crossing (near proposed Stop Number 6, Draft Itinerary);
- 3 Elm Tree Drive, Dingley Village looking to Chadwick Reserve;
- 4 Chadwick Reserve (looking West), Dingley Village; and
- 5 Park Way (East end), Braeside (looking towards Braeside Park).

We note some of these are located close to existing inspection locations.
