South Yarra Station Upgrade

February 2021

We're upgrading South Yarra Station, one of Melbourne's busiest stations, as we also prepare our network for the Metro Tunnel.

The South Yarra Station Upgrade will create a safer and more accessible space, with improvements to the entrance area and amenities, a new canopy over the station entrance and an accessible tram stop on Toorak Road.

Station and canopy works

In February, night works will continue on stage two of the South Yarra Station Upgrade.

What we are doing

- Canopy finishing works including installing new lighting and timber panels
- Upgrading the booking office and staff amenities area
- Continuing with refurbishment works inside the concourse area with restoration of the flooring and ceiling.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to mostly generate low to medium levels of noise and low levels of dust
- At times, there may be short periods of high noise however every effort will be made to complete the noisiest activities by 9pm. The timing of these works may change depending on unavoidable circumstances
- Signage and traffic management will be in place to direct pedestrians safely around the worksites. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Tram Stop service investigation works

In early February, underground service investigations will occur to inform our design and construction methodology for the tram stop upgrade in 2021. See over for location and details of upcoming night works.


What we're doing

- Setting up the work area, including wayfinding and traffic management
- Cutting and removing sections of asphalt or concrete in the road and footpaths along Toorak Road between Darling Street and William Street, South Yarra
- Using non-destructive digging machines to identify underground services beneath the road and footpath
- Reinstating the work area including filling the investigation holes with concrete or asphalt.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to mostly generate medium levels of noise and low levels of dust
- There will be periods of high noise when concrete or asphalt is cut and removed and while the non-destructive digging machines are used. Every effort will be made to minimise noise where possible
- Pedestrian access to the station, tram and shops will be maintained
- There will be no impact to tram services at South Yarra
- Signage and traffic management will be in place to direct passengers, pedestrians and traffic safely around the work areas
- For the safety of our workers, pedestrians and traffic we need to complete these activities out of hours when foot and vehicle traffic is low.

Station entrance and canopy works

- From Monday 1 February to Sunday 28 February (Sunday to Thursday only)
- Night works from 8pm to 6am.

Tram Stop service investigation works

- From Monday 8 February to Friday 12 February 2021
- Night works from 8pm to 6am.

The timing of these works may change depending on weather or unavoidable circumstances.
