Glass bottles and jars for food and drinks (intact or broken)	Soft drink, juice, water, milk bottles Beer, wine, spirits bottles Sauce, condiment, oil bottles and jars Food jars (e.g., pasta sauce, jam, pickles)	Empty, lightly rinsed Lids on (if lid can be reattached)
Glass bottles and jars for medicine, toiletries (intact or broken)	Medicine bottles Vitamin/supplement bottles Bottles and jars for toiletries/cosmetics (e.g., lotions, oils)	Empty, lightly rinsed No pumps, sprays, droppers

NOT ACCEPTED

Category	Items
Plastic bags	Bagged bottles/jars Soft plastics
Metal, plastic, paper or cardboard containers	Drink cans Plastic bottles Milk cartons Drink packaging (e.g., cardboard carriers)
Bottles or jars containing contamination	Bottles/jars with non-glass items inside them (e.g., cigarette butts, straws, food, liquid)
Loose closures from glass bottles or jars	Lids, bottle caps Corks, pumps, sprays, droppers
Glass kitchenware (intact or broken)	Drinking glasses Glass cookware (e.g., Pyrex) Crockery and ceramics Glass storage containers
