Yallock-Bulluk Marine and Coastal Park

Access and Infrastructure Plan

As part of the \$105.6 million commitment to 'Victoria's Great Outdoors' initiative, the Victorian Government is creating the Yallock-Bulluk Marine and Coastal Park. It will combine existing parks and reserves along 40kms of coast from San Remo to Inverloch. This will include a new walking trail.

The government is creating an Access and Infrastructure Plan for the new park. The plan is being developed in partnership between Parks Victoria, Bass Coast Shire Council, Bunurong Land Council Aboriginal Corporation, and the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning. The park is called Yallock-Bulluk Marine and Coastal Park.

The Access and Infrastructure Plan will include information about visitor areas, facilities, proposed walking trail routes and the various experiences people may have in the park.
