## Onshore conventional gas industry restart timeline

## Interim arrangements



The Petroleum Regulations sunsetted on May 24 2021. The current Regulations have been extended for six months. The new Regulations are anticipated to be made in October 2021.

Extending the current Regulations for a short period is intended to ensure that all community and industry feedback is effectively gathered and considered in finalising the regulations. It is a temporary extension to ensure coverage for a short period.

Authority holders will only be able to submit new operation plans (or a variation application) once the new Petroleum Regulations have commenced.

The new regulatory framework will provide for an orderly restart of activity on the ground.
