**Comments:** “Is not expected to impact” and “unlikely to be exposed to” is language that does not allow me to feel that the proposed Fingerboards Mineral Sands Project will have a positive impact on the health and well-being of our community and our environment. 1,675 hectares of the local land will be used. Approximately three gigalitres of water per year will be used. 188.5 hectares of native vegetation will be cleared. Emissions of dust and exhaust pollutants will be breathed by our families. Noise levels in the local area will increase. Our community will be exposed to radiation released from the mine site. Known and potentially unknown Aboriginal cultural heritage sites will be impacted. Rehabilitation of the site may not assist landholders and our community to re-establish a connection with our land. Money is not enough to convince me to support a project that has divided our community. I hereby submit my objection to the Fingerboards Mineral Sands Project.
