Fingerboards Mineral Sands Project Inquiry and Advisory Committee - Hearing Timetable (v8)

- All participants must adhere to current face mask requirements. This may require you to wear a mask at the Hearing Venue and whilst you are giving your presentation.

The Hearing venue is not open for observers to watch other parties' submissions except via the internet livestream. There will be no public gallery due to COVID-19 social distancing measures and density limits.


